Convert your existing 'LittleFreeLibrary' to a 'LittleFreeWildflowerArtGallery' for the month of April

It is as simple as temporarily removing the books for that month. We'll send you a colorful sign to identify as a 'Little Free Wildflower Art Gallery' with the 'Take Art, Leave Art' caption and instructions including guidelines for the public to be Covid-safe.

Interior of the gallery: Be sure there is ample room for visitors to place 3"x3" artpieces inside. We've been adding little strips of wood along the back wall for art to display, but you can also add little easels (popsicle stick) or let visitors lean their art against the base of interior walls. Some people have been decorating the interior with gallery props, such as little people viewing the art, a tiny viewing bench, a tiny vase with artificial flowers, or let your imagination have fun with creative displays.

Participants will place a 3"x3" Wildflower Art into your Little Free Wildflower Art Gallery with the option of taking, in exchange, someone else's 3"x3" Wildflower Art home. Check often during the month to see the variety of art your gallery attracts. Take photos and share on Instagram (#littlefreewildflowergallery) and on the ArtShareApril Facebook page.
